

TDS 10.4 FIRST CHOICE UNIVERSAL UNDERCOAT

DESCRIPTION:

First Choice Universal Undercoat is an economical general purpose alkyd based white undercoat with excellent flow, levelling and brushing properties. It is an excellent intermediate coating for subsequent finishing with decorative enamels and acrylics.

USES:

First Choice Universal Undercoat provides a sound key between the primer coat and subsequent finishing with decorative enamels and acrylics. It can also be used for interior and exterior purposes on a wide range of primed substrates.

SPECIFICATION OR RECOMMENDED PAINT SYSTEM:

Careful surface preparation and correct priming/ sealing is essential for a successful finish. All surfaces must be sound, clean and dry. Surfaces must be free of dust, rust, dirt, grease and other surface contamination.

- 1. <u>When used as an undercoat</u>: Ensure that the surface is clean, dry and free from dust and all foreign matter. Apply one coat of First Choice Universal Undercoat. Allow to dry for 16 hours. Not recommended on new plaster.
- 2. When used as an intermediate coat: The surface to be coated must be sanded with floor paper and then wiped clean and allowed to dry. This will improve adhesion of the undercoat. Apply one coat of First Choice Universal Undercoat. Allow to dry for 16 hours. First Choice Universal Undercoat is not designed as a finishing coat and should be overcoated within 7 days
