

TDS 4.6 WARRIOR SCHOOL BOARD PAINT

DESCRIPTION:

Warrior School Board Paint is an alkyd based, highly pigmented matt coating with excellent non-reflective properties, good abrasion resistance, which accepts chalk without skidding, and is easy to clean.

USES:

Warrior School Board Paint can be applied to any suitably primed surface, which is to be used as a black board e.g. Masonite board, steel, chipboard, fibre cement board etc. It may also be used as a decorative matt finish. It is intended for interior use only.

SPECIFICATION OR RECOMMENDED PAINT SYSTEM:

Careful surface preparation and correct priming/ sealing is essential for a successful finish. All surfaces must be sound, clean and dry. Surfaces must be free of dust, rust, dirt, grease and other surface contamination.

New Work

New composition and fibre cement boards should be sealed with Warrior Water Based Alkali Resistant Plaster Primer and allow to dry for 24 hours. Steel and wooden surfaces must be primed with the appropriate primers as per their specification.

Finish with two coats Warrior School Board Paint allowing 16 hours drying time between coats.

Previously Painted Surfaces

Remove by scraping, wire brushing or sanding all soft powdered, blistered, loose or flaking paint. Gloss or semigloss surfaces must always be sanded down with a fine abrasive to provide a good key for subsequent coats. Prime all bare areas with the appropriate primer as per their specification.

Finish with two coats Warrior School Board Paint allowing 16 hours drying time between coats.
